Board of Directors Upcoming Meetings

From The PVPOA President's Desk

With the lake level dropping, we wish to give special recognition to our maintenance supervisor, Jimmy Cantwell and his staff, for moving our marina and restaurant into deeper water. This project, in collaboration with Dependable Docks, started at midnight July 31 and took 5 to 6 hours to complete.

The POA and the PV golf course have received complaints from a resident on hole #7 and a resident representing several townhome owners on hole #4 regarding errant golf balls hitting vehicles and homes.

In an attempt to help lessen the problems with errant golf balls and trespassing...and as a sign of good faith, the PV golf course and the POA have taken the following actions:

We posted signs stating that golfers should not trespass in residents' yards, We posted signs stating that golfers are responsible for any damages caused, We installed out-of-bounds markers along the edge of the fairway at Champions Circle.

We temporarily closed the professional back tees on the PV courses' Signature Hole #7,

We hired a golf course consultant with over 30 years' experience at the POA's expense to evaluate the course hole by hole,

And we held personal meetings with two residents to discuss corrective options they could take. These options include installing awnings, carports, netting, fences, or planting shrubbery.

The golf course has been here since the 70's. Single family homes/townhomes were built around the golf course. The golf course consultant made suggestions of corrective actions, which could be taken by the homeowners. Examples include putting up protective netting on their property, installing fences, or planting shrubbery, if permitted by the ACC or owner of the land where the shrubbery would be planted.

President's Message continued.....

The POA is responsible for maintaining properties owned by the PV Property Owners Association (also known as "common areas"). Individual property owners are responsible for their private property maintenance. It would be improper to require all PV Property Owners to bear the expense of the above-mentioned corrective actions to benefit a few residents who chose to purchase a home on the golf course.

Anyone purchasing property in a golf course neighborhood is informed, *before* buying property in Point Venture, that property owners are subject to errant golf balls and the golf course owner cannot be held liable. The deed restrictions in Section IV, General Restrictions says "...the golf course in the Subdivision shall not be held liable for <u>any damages to any lot owner, their guests, or their heirs, administrators or assigns resulting from operation of said golf course."</u> NOTE: The section where the wording can be found may be different based upon what section you live in, but the wording is the same.

It is with heartfelt sympathy to hear that one of our PV residents, Whitney Vaughn, was killed in a car accident recently. Lisa Walker, a director on our board, has a 6-year-old granddaughter who was in a car accident involving a drunk driver on August 6th. At the time of this writing, she is in intensive care with many serious injuries. Please keep the Royce Christopher and Walker families in your prayers. Drive safely and please don't drink and drive.

This much I am sure of...the hottest summer ever will not last forever and rain will eventually come. Enjoy our slice of paradise and stay hydrated!

By the membership (members at the December Membership meeting) voting to approve this motion, this avoids negative tax consequences having to be paid by the Members.

This Membership Meeting will be held prior to the Regular Board of Directors' meeting on Saturday, December 9th, at 9:00 a.m.

All credit card charges are subject to a surcharge of 3.5% of the amount charged on your card.

We will NO longer accept Debit cards or American Express cards as a form of payment. If you are using a debit card or American Express card, you must contact the Admin office immediately to change your form of payment.

Your banking institution, most likely, has a "bill pay" service connected whereby owners currently using their Debit card can easily set-up the bill pay service and the result is similar to a debit transaction.

LATE FEE: A \$10 late fee is charged if we receive your payment after the 25th of the month. Please ascertain that your payment is sent to the POA on the due date, which is the first of every month!

POINT VENTURE GENERAL RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The posted speed limit on all Point Venture roads is 25 M. P. H., unless marked otherwise.
- 2. Observe all traffic signs to avoid accidents.
- 3. No Soliciting
- 4. Motorbikes/mopeds are permitted on Point Venture roads, but <u>NOT</u> in the Park area. Bicycles, skateboards, roller skates or roller blades are not allowed on the sidewalks around the office area. Bicycles are not allowed on the grass areas around the office area. THIS IS FOR THE SAFETY OF EVERYONE. PLEASE INSTRUCT YOUR CHILDREN.
- 5. No parking of vehicles on grass areas.
- 6. The discharging of guns at Point Venture is prohibited. This includes air rifles and pellet guns.
- 7. The use of fireworks at Point Venture is prohibited.
- 8. The use of outdoor cookers on wooden decks of townhouses is discouraged. The use of charcoal grills and unattended cooking is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Do not put hot coals in garbage containers or on lawns.
- 10. Burning trash, cuttings, or limbs is prohibited.
- 11. Large trucks, semi, etc. may **not** be parked overnight at Point Venture.
- 12. No Dumping in the Park..
- 13. A valid driver's license is required to operate golf carts. Minors (17 and under) are not allowed to have other minors in the golf cart when operating cart.

THE VILLAGE HAS PASSED VARIOUS ORDINANCES THAT ARE IN EFFECT AND IN ADDITION TO THE PV RULES.

REMINDERS....

PARK

It is that time of year when there is heavy use of the Park. Reminder, to access the Park, you MUST have your valid key card with you to enter through the gate. No tailgating is allowed. There are surveillance cameras at the Park and if someone is caught not adhering to the Rules and Regulations or causing a disturbance in the Park, the PVPOA staff may ask you to leave. Your access card may also be deactivated.

The renting of your personal watercraft or being hired as the captain of your own boat is against the Rules and Regulations as well. If this happens, your access card will be deactivated until further notice. Point Venture POA's common areas (this includes the Park, Gym, Swimming Pool, Tennis/Pickleball Courts, etc.) are not to be used for commercial business by members and/or guests. Since the marina/restaurant are leased out, these are included in the list of areas where individuals are not allowed to load/unload people for commercial purposes.

NO SOLICITING

There is NO SOLICITING allowed in Point Venture community at any time.



IMPORTANT NOTICE....

All owners of boats/vessels MUST fit their boats, etc. in the marina slip space. There are a few engines that hang over the roof line of the slip space and that IS NOT considered fitting into the slip space. In the event your motor/boat gets hit by another vessel and there is damage, the person who has allowed their motor to extend beyond the overhang will most all of the time, be responsible for the repair of the other party's vessel. Point Venture also retains the right to cancel any lease agreement for the marina slip at anytime due to a boat, etc. no fitting in the space accordingly.

THERE IS NO SOLICITING IN POINT VENTURE AT ANY TIME. IF SOMEONE IS SOLICITING YOU, PLEASE LET THEM KNOW IT IS NOT ALLOWED AND THEY MUST STOP.

STAGE 2 WATER RESTRICTIONS

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On August 15th, Point Venture and surrounding areas implemented Stage 2 watering restrictions.

Stage 2 Watering Restrictions Summary

- Automatic irrigation and hose-end watering is restricted to one III day per week.
- Automatic irrigation runtime is reduced by 3 hours with cutoff at 5 a.m. instead of 8 a.m.
- Water waste is prohibited.

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- Restaurants may serve water only upon request.
- There are more restrictions. This list only a few restrictions.

Failing to follow watering restrictions could result in fines of up to \$1,000 per violation. To report a violation, call 3-1-1 or use the 3-1-1 mobile app.

ARCHITECTURE CONTROL COMMITTEE

The Architecture Control Committee (ACC) meets every 2nd and 4th Monday of the month at 6:00 pm in the Venture Room, 555 Venture Blvd S

Please note the new starting time from 4:30 pm to 6 pm.

As a reminder, if you plan on making any changes to the exterior of your property/home, it MUST be reviewed and approved by the ACC BEFORE you commence work.

The ACC's intention is NOT to restrict what you do, but help find a way to do what you want while meeting the community's deed restrictions and ACC guidelines without adversely affecting your neighbors or the community in general.

The ACC Guidelines and application are posted on the Village of PV and POA websites, and a hard copy of the application is located outside the Administration office. Once completed, deposit your information into the "drop box" or email the committee.

REMINDER

Property Owners are responsible for the aesthetics of their property. The Deed Restrictions do not allow for Owners to place items on their property that are in disrepair, disarray, or unsightly. You also cannot place your vessel, RV, trailer, or anything of the like on a vacant lot unless you own the adjacent lot (on the same street) at any time. If you do own the adjacent lot, you may only place items on the lot at a minimum 25' setback *after* the easement area. Therefore, if your easement is 5' from the street view, you will need to have your items 30' from the street.

Not everything is okay to put on your lot. Any personal property you place on your lot, must be in good, working condition, and, covered, if applicable, and you may never have any vehicle, vessel, etc. resting on blocks and/or jacks, or anything comparable.

If you are not sure, ALWAYS contact the Administration office and inquire.



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IMPORTANT UPDATE!!

NEW PARK GATE HOURS - To allow property owners who love to fish, we have opened the Park gate at 5 am. Therefore, the new hours are from 5 am - midnight, daily. You must have your valid access card to enter the Park.

AMENITIES

Point Venture POA Amenities (excluding the rental of Club Room) may not be used to provide, conduct, or solicit any activity, program, or other event for profit, financial gain, commercial use or otherwise by any business or person. This does not include EBR's (Established business relationships such as the marina restaurant/ship's store, Liquid Thrillz and food truck) conducting business on PVPOA property. Members found to be using the PVPOA amenities in the above manner are subject to immediate disciplinary action including, but not limited to suspension or permanent expulsion from utilizing the PVPOA amenities.

HOURS OF OPERATIONS

Gym Hours Open 7 days 4 am - 10 pm

Be courteous to those around you. Sharing equipment provides a healthy environment. Wipe down equipment after use. Shirts and shoes required.

Once you are done with the weights, return them to their proper spot.

Pool Hours Open 7 days 7:30 am - 10 pm

No glass, alcohol, smoking, pets, grills, skateboarding, or automotive-type of tubes. Trash must be placed in receptacles. Furniture returned to their original location.

Park Hours Open 7 days 5 am - Midnight

The Park speed is 15 m.p.h. Trash must be placed in receptacles, including dog waste (dog waste stations are provided). Playscape is off limits to pets. Do not let your dog loose in the playscape area.

Library Open 7 days 6 am - 10 pm

Golf Hours Open 7 days 7 am - Dark

No walking, running, bikes or skateboards allowed on cart paths. You may not tee off until you have checked in with the Pro Shop. Golf is not open during inclement weather.

Caddie Shack Hours Tuesday - Saturday 7 am - 11 pm

Sunday - Monday 7 am - 9 pm

Admin Office Monday - Friday 7 am - 3 pm

(closed holidays)

Marina Rules

No fishing or swimming around, or any part of, the marina, it's walkways, the restaurant or Ship's Store at any time. Comply with NO WAKE buoys. All watercraft using our Marina will be towed away at the violators expense. You may not use the dock/marina to pick up passengers who have hired you or your watercraft at any time. Those individuals and you are subject to criminal trespassing.
