## From The PVPOA President's Desk

### STATE OF THE ASSOCIATION

We just completed our June election for three positions on the board of directors. There were 7 candidates vying for three directors' positions. 450 ballots were cast. Charlotte Cook was elected and Angela Kurth and Dan Anglin were re-elected. I would like to personally thank and congratulate all the candidates and the community for their outstanding participation.

Due in large part to steps our board has taken, the financial objectives of the association are being addressed and achieved. The POA board's fiduciary goals continue to focus on paying down the large POA debt as well as funding the reserves adequately.

Amount of Marina Reserved Cash as of 5/31/2023	\$81,110.00

The Marina Reserved Cash account will continue building until January of 2027 and at that time will be applied to the marina portion of the note.

In last month's meeting, the board approved hiring a reserve study company that will conduct a full, on-site study, which has not occurred since 2007. A reserve study specialist is tasked with identifying all the assets of the POA and presenting them in a detailed report. Assets useful life will be evaluated.

Here are examples of items in a reserve study: replacing windows in the complex buildings, resurfacing the tennis/pickleball courts, maintaining the POAs utility equipment, roofing and HVAC replacements, ongoing marina maintenance, and repairs to POA amenities due to storm damage.

This study will assist the Board of Directors in determining how much of the property owners' assessment money will be earmarked for the reserve fund each year.

***President's Message continued.....***

Recently, an Ad Hoc committee was formed to evaluate the needs of the tennis/pickleball courts. Board director John Cowher is leading the committee. Currently, two of the four tennis courts are being used for pickleball and those two courts are in the most urgent need of resurfacing. Capital expenditure money was approved in this year's budget, yet the cost exceeds our apportionment. So, those repairs/upgrades may need to wait until 2024.

Deed restriction enforcement is ongoing. Residents are being notified that car, boats, and trailers cannot be parked in front yards inside the 25' setback, nor can vehicles remain parked in the right-of-way. Our GM, Lori Martin, has been sending letters to the residents who are not following community regulations. The Village and the POA are in a cooperative effort to address and enforce ordinances and deed restriction violations.

The POA will continue moving forward to update antiquated deed restrictions. **Updating deed restrictions** will provide a more effective enforcement of deed restrictions with the ability to fine violators.

Our POA board's fiduciary goals continue to focus on **debt retirement and building reserves**. This will ensure that our association remains financially strong and solvent for future years. The future of PV is in everyone's hands. Our neighborhood is evolving. Water treatment plant expansions are underway, Venture Mart will soon be opening, and our future as a resort community is very positive!

By the membership (members at the December Membership meeting) voting to approve this motion, this avoids negative tax consequences having to be paid by the Members.

2023 Assessments are **\$120/month**.

Please make sure you update any payment information with us ASAP.

All credit card charges are subject to a **surcharge of 3.5%** of the amount charged on your card.

We will **NO** longer accept **Debit cards** or **American Express cards** as a form of payment. If you are using a debit card or American Express card, you must contact the Admin office immediately to change your form of payment.

Your banking institution, most likely, has a “**bill pay**” service connected whereby owners currently using their Debit card can easily set-up the bill pay service and the result is similar to a debit transaction.

**LATE FEE:** A \$10 late fee is charged if we receive your payment after the 25th of the month. Please ascertain that your payment is sent to the POA on the due date, which is the **first of every month!**

## POINT VENTURE GENERAL RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The posted speed limit on all Point Venture roads is 25 M. P. H., unless marked otherwise.
2. Observe all traffic signs to avoid accidents.
3. No Soliciting
4. Motorbikes/mopeds are permitted on Point Venture roads, but NOT in the park area. Bicycles, skateboards, roller skates or roller blades are not allowed on the sidewalks around the office area. Bicycles are not allowed on the grass areas around the office area. **THIS IS FOR THE SAFETY OF EVERYONE. PLEASE INSTRUCT YOUR CHILDREN.**
5. No parking of vehicles on grass areas.
6. The discharging of guns at Point Venture is prohibited. This includes air rifles and pellet guns.
7. The use of fireworks at Point Venture is prohibited.
8. The use of outdoor cookers on wooden decks of townhouses is discouraged. The use of charcoal grills and unattended cooking is strictly prohibited.
9. Do not put hot coals in garbage containers or on lawns.
10. Burning trash, cuttings, or limbs is prohibited.
11. Large trucks, semi, etc. may **not** be parked overnight at Point Venture.
12. No Dumping in the Park..
13. A valid driver's license is required to operate golf carts. Minors (17 and under) are not allowed to have other minors in the golf cart when operating cart.

## General Manager's Report - June 2023

### ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING—JUNE 10, 2023

The members of the POA adopted an emergency Resolution regarding "Excess Income Applied to the 2022 Year's Assessments Revenue Ruling 70-604." This ruling was required to be voted on by the members of PVPOA to avoid negative tax consequences and it saved the membership approximately \$30,000.

### OTHER INFO

#### **Debit Cards**

Some of you still have your debit cards attached to your account for monthly assessment payments. If you are still using your debit card, you need to contact the Admin office and change it immediately. **Your payments using a debit card, even with the ability to use it as a credit card, will be rejected effective IMMEDIATELY** and your payment will be returned. *(If it is connected to your bank account, in the end it is still a debit card, even if you use it as a credit card.)* This could cause your account to have an outstanding balance and may incur late fees. If you don't check your account and update your payment information, after a certain amount of time, your account goes to Collections.

#### **Park**

It is that time of year when there is heavy use of the Park. Reminder, to access the Park, you MUST have your valid key card with you to enter through the gate. No tailgating is allowed. There are surveillance cameras at the Park and if someone is caught not adhering to the Rules and Regulations or causing a disturbance in the Park, the PVPOA staff may ask you to leave. Your access card may also be deactivated.

The renting of your personal watercraft or being hired as the captain of your own boat is against the Rules and Regulations as well. If this happens, your access card will be deactivated until further notice. Point Venture POA's common areas (this includes the Park, Gym, Swimming Pool, Tennis/Pickleball Courts, etc.) are not to be used for commercial business by members and/or guests. Since the marina/restaurant are leased out, these are included in the list of areas where individuals are not allowed to load/unload people for commercial purposes.

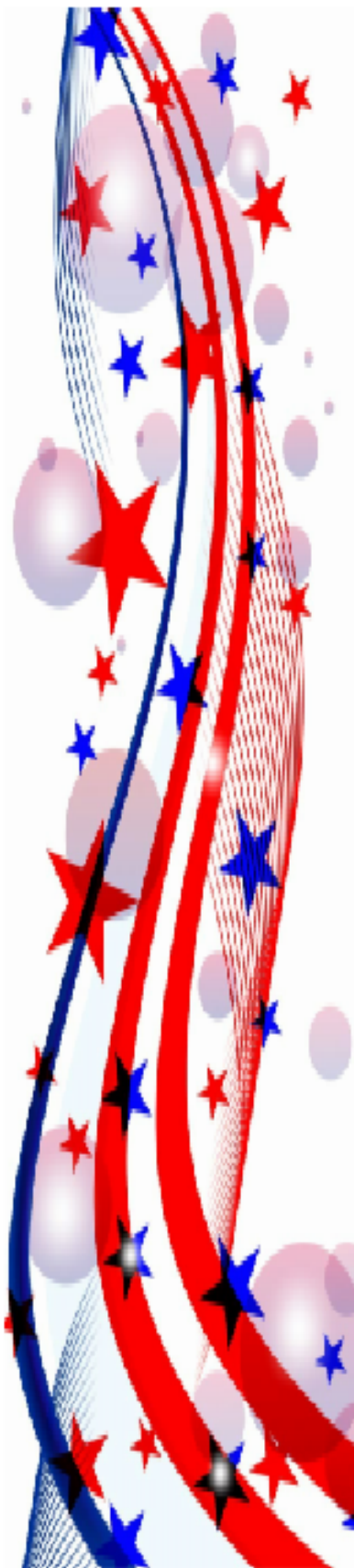

# ARCHITECTURE CONTROL COMMITTEE

The Architecture Control Committee (ACC) meets every 2nd and 4th Monday of the month at 6:00 pm in the Venture Room, 555 Venture Blvd S

**\*\*Please note the new starting time from 4:30 pm to 6 pm.\*\***

As a reminder, if you plan on making any changes to the exterior of your property/home, it MUST be reviewed and approved by the ACC BEFORE you commence work.

The ACC's intention is NOT to restrict what you do, but help find a way to do what you want while meeting the community's deed restrictions and ACC guidelines without adversely affecting your neighbors or the community in general.

The ACC Guidelines and application are posted on the Village of PV and POA websites, and a hard copy of the application is located outside the Administration office. Once completed, deposit your information into the "drop box" or email the committee.

## REMINDER

Property Owners are responsible for the aesthetics of their property. The Deed Restrictions do not allow for Owners to place items on their property that are in disrepair, disarray, or unsightly. You also cannot place your vessel, RV, trailer, or anything of the like on a vacant lot unless you own the adjacent lot (on the same street) at any time. If you do own the adjacent lot, you may only place items on the lot at a minimum 25' setback *after* the easement area. Therefore, if your easement is 5' from the street view, you will need to have your items 30' from the street.

Not everything is okay to put on your lot. Any personal property you place on your lot, must be in good, working condition, and, covered, if applicable, and you may never have any vehicle, vessel, etc. resting on blocks and/or jacks, or anything comparable.

**NEW PARK GATE HOURS** - To allow property owners who love to fish, we have opened the Park gate at 5 am. Therefore, the new hours are from 5 am - midnight, daily. You must have your valid access card to enter the Park.

This does not include EBR's (Established business relationships such as the marina restaurant/ship's store, Liquid Thrillz and food truck) conducting business on PVPOA property. **Members found to be using the PVPOA amenities in the above manner are subject to immediate disciplinary action including, but not limited to suspension or permanent expulsion from utilizing the PVPOA amenities.**

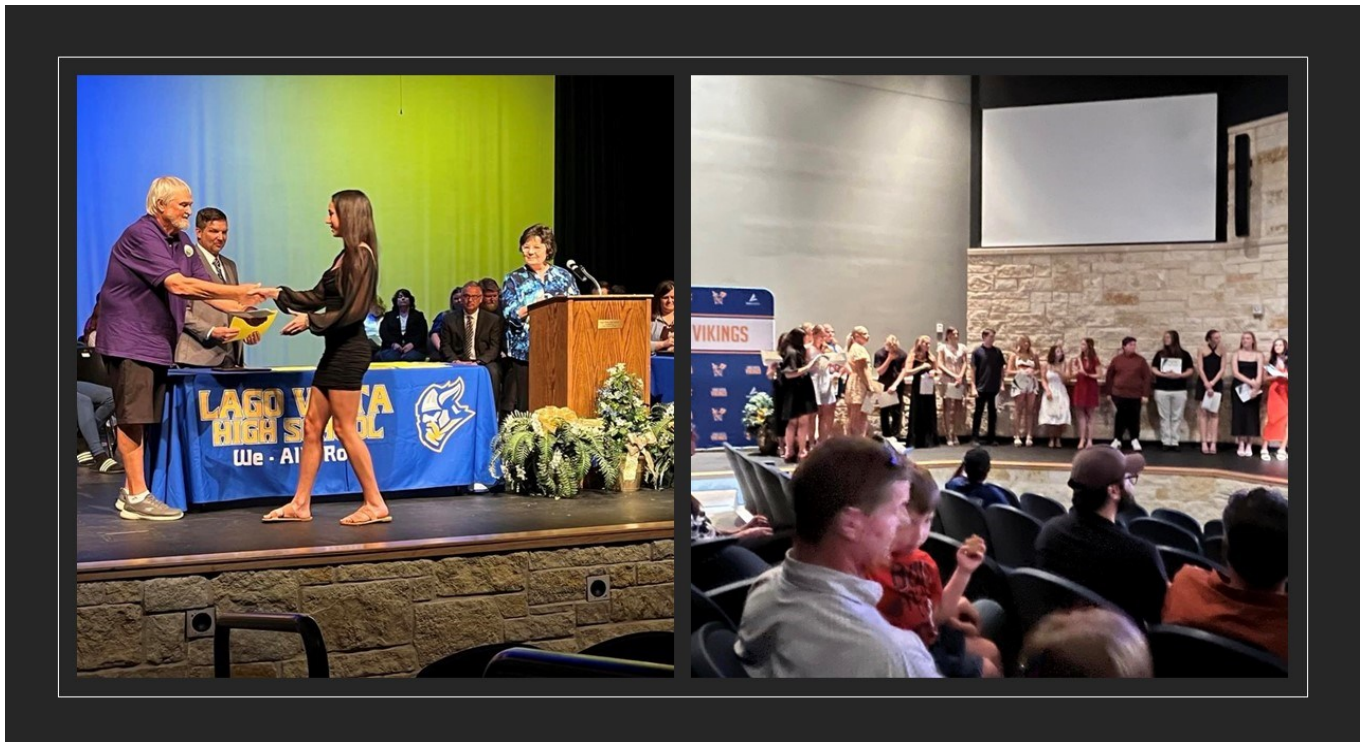

Since it is so busy, I wanted to remind you of a few items on the golf side. Golfers are responsible for any damage to property on and around the golf course. Also, please respect private property; do not enter a yard to retrieve a ball. You may be cited for trespassing. Everyone must make a tee time and check into the golf shop to tee off on hole #1. Remember, if you have filled out one of the Membership forms up here at the golf shop you are a Member of the golf course. For your convenience, all Members may make a profile on our website [www.PointVentureGolf.com](http://www.PointVentureGolf.com) with the email address we have on file in our GolfNow system. You may then book a tee time through our website using your profile with no transaction fee. Once you have booked your tee time, please check into the golf shop. Just a reminder that you may use your private cart unlimited if you pay the \$110/month trail fee. If you do not get to play enough to justify the \$110/month, we do offer a daily trail fee to use your own cart per round. The cost is \$15 per person for 9 holes or \$22 per person for 18 holes. If you do not have your own cart, you may rent one of ours for \$24 per person for 18 holes, or \$17 per person for 9 holes. Finally, please keep your carts on the cart path around the tees and greens and on all par 3's and no more than 4 players to a group.

Also, a reminder with our updated beer and wine license map, you may NO LONGER bring any Beer or Wine on to the golf course property. All beer and wine and mixers (anything under 14% alcohol) MUST be purchased at the Caddie Shack. Finally, all drinks must be in one of our cups, you may not bring any type of container such as a YETI on to the property. These rules are in place to protect our TABC license, not to be difficult. Additionally, there is no smoking (cigarettes or illegal drugs) or vaping in the Caddie Shack or on the outdoor deck. For your convenience, we have created an area with tables, chairs, and ash trays outside the glass garage doors for smoking cigarettes and vaping. Please help us by abiding by all the rules that have been put in place – THANK YOU!

We had a tough winter with the overseed and the ice storm! We are finally getting some warmer weather and the Bermuda is growing, the greens are getting better and should be in awesome condition by the 4<sup>th</sup> of July! Limbs continue to fall and the cleanup will continue throughout the year.
