Our board would like to congratulate our General Manager, Lori Martin, for her accomplishment of earning her LSM, Large Scale Manager certification, available only through Community Associations Institute. There are only 80 active LSM's in the world and Lori has joined those lofty ranks. Please help us congratulate Lori in her accomplishment!

Our community, like other areas in central Texas, has been dealing with the damage caused by the ice storm. Many, many, trees, and shrubs were broken off or completely uprooted from the ground due to heavy ice. The Village, the POA, and the PVTHA have all been cooperating to resolve this brush issue. The Village recently hired a company to remove limbs and brush in the neighborhood and park. Lone Star Forestry Mulching will remove right-of-way brush, mulch the brush in the park, and remove the mulch. Since it is a fire hazard due to heat build-up causing spontaneous combustion, the mulch needs to be removed. Lone Star's bid is based upon what is currently in the right-of-way and in the park. Absolutely **NO DUMPING** will be permitted in our park now or in the future. The debris removal process began March 15th.

Due to the ever-increasing popularity of pickleball, the POA is considering converting two of our four tennis courts into four pickleball courts. The refurbishing of all four courts is planned for this year and it would be a great time to add these increasingly popular pickleball courts.

POINT VENTURE GENERAL RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The posted speed limit on all Point Venture roads is 25 M. P. H., unless marked otherwise.
- 2. Observe all traffic signs to avoid accidents.
- 3. Motorbikes/mopeds are permitted on Point Venture roads, but <u>NOT</u> in the park area. Riding is NOT allowed on terraces (grassy areas) or sidewalks around the office area or on private lawns.
- 4. Bicycles, skateboards, roller skates or roller blades are not allowed on the sidewalks around the office area. Bicycles are not allowed on the grass areas around the office area. THIS IS FOR THE SAFETY OF EVERYONE. PLEASE INSTRUCT YOUR CHILDREN.
- 5. No parking of vehicles on grass areas.
- 6. The discharging of guns at Point Venture is prohibited. This includes air rifles and pellet guns.
- 7. The use of fireworks at Point Venture is prohibited.
- 8. The use of outdoor cookers on wooden decks of townhouses is discouraged. The use of charcoal grills and unattended cooking is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Do not put hot coals in garbage containers or on lawns.
- 10. Burning trash, cuttings, or limbs is prohibited.
- 11. Large trucks, semi, etc. may **not** be parked overnight at Point Venture.
- 12. No Dumping in the Park..
- 13. A valid driver's license is required to operate golf carts. Minors (17 and under) are not allowed to have other minors in the golf cart when operating cart.

From the General Manager

As mentioned in the most recent newsletter (October 2022), the Board of Directors and I are committed to being "more" transparent to the Property Owners. We've added the 2022 and 2023 Financials for each month to the Website (Once the Board has acknowledged them in a meeting; which was done at the March 11, 2023 meeting).

I also am including the recent motions and other agenda items from the last Board meeting on March 11, 2023.

There were two (2) motions passed as follows on March 11thth:

(1) Discussion of the approval of the agreement between the Village and the POA for the POA's Bobcat/backhoe services on a scheduled basis and to include compensation for maintenance and labor provided by the POA.

Motion unanimously approved

(2) Motion to approve an increase for the Club Room rental/cleaning fee & deposit to \$75 each. This is due to the cost (\$60 minimum for each event) to clean the clubroom after each use. The deposit fee will still be refundable if the Clubroom is left clean and trash placed in accordance with instructions from staff. Motion unanimously approved

The Agenda also included a Motion to clarify the Bylaws regarding where/when the Membership (aka Property Owners) may vote on agenda items. The POA's legal counsel has opined that in accordance to State Property codes, including subparagraphs, and the Association's Bylaws, Members/Property Owners can vote at "Membership Meetings" and Board Members can vote at "Board Meetings".

This item was tabled at the March 11th meeting and the POA will send out another USPS written notice to the property owners of when the item will be discussed and voted on again at a future Board meeting. This will, most likely, be on the May's Board meeting Agenda.

STATUS OF DEBRIS FROM ICE STORM

The Village recently approved a vendor, Lone Star Tree Service, has begun collecting the debris at each property owners' lots. The tree service's truck will not be making additional passes onto streets they have already driven so if you missed the pickup service, the property owner will need to make arrangements to remove the debris from their yard/right-of-way.

The POA wood chipped their debris, which includes the golf course, and ascertained that we were out of their way when they came. As always, please watch where you walk or drive in the Park area at all times.

MINORS DRIVING GOLF CARTS

I received a call recently from the Sheriff's Department about minors driving golf carts in the community, especially with several other minors in the cart. This is ILLEGAL and the Sheriff's department takes this seriously. The deputy Sheriff said they came out and found a few teenagers driving other younger kids around in a golf cart. First, you must have a driver's license to operate a golf cart and if you are 17 or younger, you cannot have other minors in the cart with you. The Sheriff's department intends to come out, especially when called, and locate the teens and their parents. There also may be a fine incurred if they come out more than once for the same minors.

SOCIAL GATHERINGS

The Board has decided on the 2023 Social Gatherings that take place at the Caddie Shack. Everyone is invited to attend and meet your neighbors and have fun! The dates are April 5th, August 23rd and December 6th starting at 6 pm. We will re-announce the dates when they get closer.

NOMINATION FORMS

The 2023 election of Board members is coming up. There are 3 seats that will come up for election. In this issue, you will find a nomination form if you are interested in serving on the Board. The form, along with an informational flyer, must be received in the Admin office no later than 2 pm on April 3rd. If there are only 3 nominees for 3 positions on April 3rd, an election will not need to occur and those 3 candidates will be deemed elected. If there are more than 3, ballots will be sent out around May 1st.

DEBIT/CREDIT CARDS

As a reminder, there is a surcharge on credit cards, and we can no longer accept debit cards as payment for your assessments or the leasing of the marina slips, boat storage and trailer storage. Please contact the Administration office and provide updated payment information; otherwise, your account will become late and incur late fees. If you are using a debit card now, you can also go online through your bank and set-up automatic payments to the Association through them. This type of payment is called an ACH, or Automatic Clearing House. Once you set that up, it will be almost like your debit card but we won't have your debit card number. If you go this route, please be sure to reference your account number on the check / bill payment.

Easter is on April 9th and I want to announce early that the regular Easter Egg hunt will be held on April 8th at the Point Venture Park. The start time is 10:00 a.m. It is hosted by the Lions' Club and is always fun and exciting for everyone.

There are a few items in the Bylaws that need clarification or updated per legal counsel. The official notice will contain any proposed revisions. This item was tabled until the May 13th meeting.

NEW CLUBHOUSE ROOM CHARGE

Effective immediately, any member wishing to rent the Club Room will be charged \$75 per usage and \$75 for the (refundable) deposit. We request two (2) checks be written; one for \$75 - which will be cashed. The second one for \$75 - which we will retain in the event the room is left with the need for additional cleaning than normal wear and tear.

IMPORTANT UPDATE!!

NEW PARK GATE HOURS - To allow property owners who love to fish, we have opened the Park gate at 5 am. Therefore, the new hours are from 5 am - midnight, daily.

AMENITIES

Point Venture POA Amenities (excluding the rental of Club Room) may not be used to provide, conduct, or solicit any activity, program, or other event for profit, financial gain, commercial use or otherwise by any business or person. This does not include EBR's (Established business relationships such as the marina restaurant/ship's store, Liquid Thrillz and food truck) conducting business on PVPOA property. Members found to be using the PVPOA amenities in the above manner are subject to immediate disciplinary action including, but not limited to suspension or permanent expulsion from utilizing the PVPOA amenities.

ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL COMMITTEE (ACC)

The ACC meets every second and fourth Monday at 4:30 p.m. in the Venture Room, located at 555 Venture Blvd. So, Point Venture, Texas.

There also is a "drop box" outside the POA office for property owners to drop off their applications. Someone from the ACC will be in charge to retrieve the applications from the (locked) box for each ACC meeting. The new email for the ACC is:

As a reminder, any exterior change to your property/home MUST be reviewed and approved by the ACC BEFORE you commence work.

The ACC's intention is NOT to restrict what you do, but help find a way to do what you want while meeting the community's deed restrictions and ACC guidelines without adversely affecting your neighbors or the community in general.

The ACC Guidelines are posted on the Village and Point Venture's websites.

REMINDER

Property Owners are responsible for the aesthetics of their property. The Deed Restrictions do not allow for Owners to place items on their property that are in disrepair, disarray, or unsightly. You also cannot place your vessel, RV, trailer, or anything of the like on a vacant lot unless you own the adjacent lot (on the same street) at any time. If you do own the adjacent lot, you may only place items on the lot at a minimum 25' setback *after* the easement area. Therefore, if your easement is 5' from the street view, you will need to have your items 30' from the street.

Not everything is okay to put on your lot. Any personal property you place on your lot, must be in good, working condition, and, covered, if applicable, and you may never have any vehicle, vessel, etc. resting on blocks and/or jacks, or anything comparable.

HOURS OF OPERATIONS

Gym Hours Open 7 days 5 am - 10 pm

Be courteous to those around you. Sharing equipment provides a healthy environment. Wipe down equipment after use. Shirts and shoes required.

Once you are done with the weights, return them to their proper spot.

Pool Hours Open 7 days 7:30 am - 10 pm

No glass, alcohol, smoking, pets, grills, skateboarding, or automotive-type of tubes. Trash must be placed in receptacles. Furniture returned to their original location.

Park Hours Open 7 days 5 am - Midnight

The Park speed is 15 m.p.h. Trash must be placed in receptacles, including dog waste (dog waste stations are provided). Playscape is off limits to pets. Do not let your dog loose in the playscape area.

Golf Hours Open 7 days 7 am - Dark

No walking, running, bikes or skateboards allowed on cart paths. You may not tee off until you have checked in with the Pro Shop. Golf is not open during inclement weather.

Caddie Shack Hours Tuesday - Saturday 7 am - 11 pm Sunday - Monday 7 am - 9 pm

Marina Rules

No fishing or swimming around, or any part of, the marina, it's walkways, the restaurant or Ship's Store at any time. Comply with NO WAKE buoys. All watercraft using our Marina will be towed away at the violators expense. You may not use the dock/marina to pick up passengers who have hired you or your watercraft at any time. Those individuals and you are subject to criminal trespassing.

GOLF NEWS...

I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for your support throughout 2022 and the beginning of 2023. The golf course and Caddie Shack have been extremely busy with revenues at an all-time high last year and we are well ahead of that pace already again this year.

Since it is so busy, I wanted to remind you of a few items on the golf side. Everyone must make a tee time and check into the golf shop to tee off on hole #1. Remember, if you have filled out one of the Membership forms up here at the golf shop you are a Member of the golf course. For your convenience, all Members may make a profile on our website www.PointVentureGolf.com with the email address we have on file in our GolfNow system. You may then book a tee time through our website using your profile with no transaction fee. Once you have booked your tee time, please check into the golf shop. Just a reminder that you may use your private cart unlimited if you pay the \$110/month trail fee. If you do not get to play enough to justify the \$110/month, we do offer a daily trail fee to use your own cart per round. The cost is \$15 per person for 9 holes or \$22 per person for 18 holes. If you do not have your own cart, you may rent one of ours for \$24 per person for 18 holes, or \$17 per person for 9 holes. Finally, please keep your carts on the cart path around the tees and greens and on all par 3's and no more than 4 players to a group.

Also, a reminder with our updated beer and wine license map, you may NO LONGER bring any Beer or Wine on to the golf course property. All beer and wine and mixers (anything under 14% alcohol) MUST be purchased at the Caddie Shack. Finally, all drinks must be in one of our cups, you may not bring any type of container such as a YETI on to the property. These rules are in place to protect our TABC license, not to be difficult. Additionally, there is no smoking (cigarettes or illegal drugs) or vaping in the Caddie Shack or on the outdoor deck. For your convenience we have created an area with tables, chairs, and ash trays outside the glass garage doors for smoking cigarettes and vaping. Please help us by abiding by all the rules that have been put in place – THANK YOU!

We had a tough winter with the overseed and the ice storm! Like most courses in Central Texas, we had a lot of poa annua on the greens and thousands of limbs down all over the golf course. We sprayed the poa annua early so the greens were not so bumpy, but the Bermuda grass has not fully come out of dormancy yet. We need some warm nights to get the Bermuda growing! As far as the ice storm goes, we made the course playable within a couple days by getting all the limbs off the ground, but we will continue to cut down hanging limbs for the next month or so. We also completed a large irrigation system maintenance project this winter to help us get better coverage on the golf course this year and hopefully eliminate hot spots in the main playing areas next summer. Once we get some warmer weather and start getting this Bermuda growing, the golf course should be in awesome condition here in a couple months!

We have our weekly golf leagues in the morning at 9am including Maddog Mondays, Women's Golf Association on Tuesday, Men's Golf Association Wednesdays, Thursday Mixed League, and the Friday Cash Game. We also have a 9-hole scramble on Saturdays at 3pm. We also have a major tournament every 3 weeks or so on the weekends and are adding a Men's League on Tuesday nights at 5pm, our Wednesday Night Scramble at 5pm, a Skins Game at 12:30pm on Thursdays, and a

Women's League at 5pm on Thursday nights for those of you who work during the week. Make sure you get signed up on our Golf Genius Tournament Software, so you receive all the invitations for these great events.

We also have all of our nightly activities in the Caddie Shack and our rotating food trucks. The food trucks are there from 10am-2pm & 5-9pm Fridays – Mondays and 5-9pm on Tuesday-Thursday. 
