From The PVPOA President's Desk

We would like to thank those members who came to our last board meeting on May 13th. We would also like to thank our association attorney, Gregory Cagle, a partner in the Cagle Pugh Law Firm, for attending and addressing some issues pertinent to the POA and community. Gregory Cagle is the author of the book "Texas Homeowners Association Law: The Essential Legal Guide for Texas Homeowners Associations and Homeowners" now in its fourth edition.

Our current POA board of directors is comprised of volunteers coming from different backgrounds, education, and work experiences. Sometimes it is necessary to reach out and consult with professionals that specialize in certain aspects of directing our association. We must rely upon their help and direction in managing our association, in order to be the best fiduciary possible for the association and all property owners. These specialists come at a cost. Whether it be needing an IT company, a QuickBooks expert, an audit company, an accountant, or a lawyer to navigate our direction, these professionals are hired to provide the very best counsel to our association.

So, when we receive a suggestion from our accountant or get a legal opinion from our attorney, we usually prefer to follow their recommendations.

For the first time in eight years, we will be having an election for the POA board. Thanks to all candidates that want to volunteer to selflessly serve our community!

Some candidates running for the POA board have stated their desire for more transparency concerning financial decisions made by the board. Let me address both necessary increases. The boat slip rental increase was a necessary step to address the outstanding marina balloon payment of \$873,581.22 that would have been due May 2023. The POA fee increase was necessary to help offset inflation rates, pay down debt, and allow us to build reserves. Our POA board's fiduciary goals continue to focus on **debt retirement, building reserves, and updating deed restrictions** to allow for enforcement of current deed restrictions. Updating deed restrictions is the POA's next challenging hurdle.

President's Message continued.....

The POA is actively looking for a legal path forward to address non-compliant and troublesome STR owners and tenants.

After our winter ice storm, the PV POA private park was designated a temporary storage area by the TCEQ for the downed limbs and debris. Our board would like to take this opportunity to extend our appreciation to the Village for their commitment to remove storm debris from our community and return our park to its original condition.

Our board previously approved fencing a portion of the south POA parking lot for the relocation of boat and trailer storage during the water treatment plant upgrades. This was done at the request of the WCID. This would then allow the WCID to use the vacated space for a parking and staging area during the 2 ½-3 years for the completion of the water treatment project. Recently, the WCID has decided to utilize two of their lots across from the WCID office, for trailer and boat relocation. The POA parking lot no longer needs to be converted into a fenced boat/trailer parking area.

Finally, it was suggested at our May 13th meeting that the POA should be charging Liquid Thrillz the same per-slip rental that current POA slip lessees are paying. The POA is only leasing the shoreline, which Liquid Thrillz uses to anchor and access their company dock. Liquid Thrillz, not the POA, has paid for their dock construction, walkway and all installations and maintains the dock. Liquid Thrillz carries and pays for the necessary insurance, and meets all LCRA requirements to operate on Lake Travis. For those reasons, the slip rental rates cannot be compared. Liquid Thrillz has an Established Business Relationship (EBR) with the POA which benefits ALL property owners and guests!

I would like to offer my heartfelt thanks to our current board, Jim Hawkins, John Cowher, Kristi Adamcik, Brandon Baird, Angela Kurth, Lisa Walker, Mary Spinks, and Dan Anglin for their wisdom, guidance, fortitude, and courage in making the difficult decisions that this board has had to address to make this association strong and solvent.

We are looking forward to a wonderful summer in our beautiful piece of paradise, Point Venture, "Where Every Day is A Holiday!" Enjoy your summer!

POINT VENTURE GENERAL RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The posted speed limit on all Point Venture roads is 25 M. P. H., unless marked otherwise.
- 2. Observe all traffic signs to avoid accidents.
- Motorbikes/mopeds are permitted on Point Venture roads, but <u>NOT</u> in the park area. Bicycles, skateboards, roller skates or roller blades are not allowed on the sidewalks around the office area. Bicycles are not allowed on the grass areas around the office area. THIS IS FOR THE SAFETY OF EVERYONE. PLEASE INSTRUCT YOUR CHILDREN.
- 4. No parking of vehicles on grass areas.
- 5. The discharging of guns at Point Venture is prohibited. This includes air rifles and pellet guns.
- 6. The use of fireworks at Point Venture is prohibited.
- 7. The use of outdoor cookers on wooden decks of townhouses is discouraged. The use of charcoal grills and unattended cooking is strictly prohibited.
- 8. Do not put hot coals in garbage containers or on lawns.
- 9. Burning trash, cuttings, or limbs is prohibited.
- 10. Large trucks, semi, etc. may **not** be parked overnight at Point Venture.
- 12. No Dumping in the Park..
- 13. A valid driver's license is required to operate golf carts. Minors (17 and under) are not allowed to have other minors in the golf cart when operating cart.

From the General Manager

At the last Board meeting on May 13, 2023, the Board of Directors approved the following motions:

- (1) Revision to Bylaws regarding clarifying Members can vote at "Membership" meetings. *Motion unanimously approved*
- (2) Ratification of the agreement between the Village and the POA for services using the POA's backhoe on a monthly basis. *Motion unanimously approved*
- (3) Approval of Onsite, Full Reserve Study in the amount of \$7,200
 With Global Solutions Partners. *Motion approved*
- (4) Approval of Foreclosure (Confidential) *Motion unanimously approved*

The POA's general counsel, Greg Cagle, was present for the meeting and spoke on the clarification required to be made in the Bylaws because of confusion among some residents. Essentially, he commented/opined that the Bylaws state that "Members" can vote at "Membership Meetings" while "Board Members" can vote at "Board Meetings".

Mr. Cagle also spoke on why the Board of Directors do not have the ability to go after STRs in the neighbor, or the actions of their guests (which those actions usually require the Sheriff's office to get involved). The deed restriction will need to be amended to include any fine, etc. before the Board could take such action against STR owners or limit how many STRs the community association will allow. The Board's goal has been to get the governing document (deed restrictions) amended but it will take a lot of team effort through-out the community, especially since there are 14 separate deed restrictions recorded in Point Venture.

That means that I will be in search of people from each section to head up getting the vote count returned to us to make the needed changes. More information to come from the Board and I shortly.

Mr. Cagle also discussed errant golf balls and although the governing documents say that the golf course owner (aka POA) has no responsibility for the actions of the golf player, this current Board has taken a stance to seek out a golf architect/consultant to listen to that person's thoughts and ideas how to get some relief for the homeowners who are experiencing excessive, errant golf balls. Your Board of Directors are hard at work coming up with possible solutions and are paying for the golf architect to guide them.

General Manager's Report - May 2023

Debit Cards

Some of you still have your debit cards attached to your account for monthly assessment payments. If you are still using your debit card, you need to contact the Admin office and change it immediately. Your payments using a debit card, even with the ability to use it as a credit card, will be <u>rejected</u>, and your payment will be returned. This could cause your account to have an outstanding balance and may incur late fees. If you don't check your account and update your payment information, after a certain amount of time, your account goes to Collections.

As mentioned, you can go directly to your banking institution's website and follow the instructions on how to set up automatic or one-time bill pay and it is the same process whereby the funds come directly from your bank account like a debit card and there is no cost that I have ever seen or heard about. Starting June 1, our system will be removing debit card information and if you haven't provided a new form of payment, your account will show "non-payment" and we don't send out reminders until an account becomes past due and incurs additional fees. So please be cognizant and confirm you are not using a debit card to pay.

TENNIS AND PICKLEBALL AD-HOC COMMITTEE

RESERVE STUDY

The Board decided on a reserve study company and that company will conduct a full, on-site reserve study of all your asset components and their projected life span and include a recommendation on how much of your assessments should be contributed to the Reserve Fund going forward for the repair, replacement and/or maintenance of those components. The last time a Reserve study was done was 2007 so a fresh, new one will be interesting to review and use as a guiding tool.

PROPOSED BYLAW CHANGE

All property owners were sent a letter noticing this meeting as well as an overview of what is going to be voted on to change. The Board approved the simple change by adding an adjective (under the "Members" section (2)). The adjective was "Membership", which will be placed in front of the word "members" in the Bylaws so that it's clear when members in the audience can vote at "Membership Meetings". This update will be filed with the county as soon as possible. From the General Manager continued....

JULY 4TH T-SHIRTS



The shirts will arrive within the next 7 days. The shirt is a more softer material than last year's material and is more of a baby or sky blue. T-Shirt sales will begin when we receive them and we will make an announcement when we get them. T-Shirts are \$22 each this year due to pretty much everything going up since a year ago, including the cost of the T-Shirts. Reminder, we cannot accept credit cards or debit cards any longer for payment. But we do accept checks or cash. And, for some, I WAS able to get XS youth size this year. There were a few people requesting the XS youth size last year.

BALLOT COUNTING

All Ballots must be received in the POA Admin office by June 7th, 2 pm. Official counting day is Friday morning, June 9th beginning at 9 am in the Venture Room. There will be a few volunteer people who will be the official designated "tick-mark" counters and one person actually reading from the ballot and calling off the votes aloud. Owners in the audience can also keep count as they are being announced. Only myself, Roy Ables (who has done this for many years in the past as the "caller -out" person), and another staff person will be allowed to see the ballots according to state law. The top 3 vote getters will be the new board members and will be seated at the Saturday meeting, June 10th, 9 am in the Venture Room.

ARCHITECTURE CONTROL COMMITTEE

The Architecture Control Committee (ACC) meets every 2nd and 4th Monday of the month at 6:00 pm in the Venture Room, 555 Venture Blvd S

Please note the new starting time from 4:30 pm to 6 pm.

As a reminder, if you plan on making any changes to the exterior of your property/home, it MUST be reviewed and approved by the ACC BEFORE you commence work.

The ACC's intention is NOT to restrict what you do, but help find a way to do what you want while meeting the community's deed restrictions and ACC guidelines without adversely affecting your neighbors or the community in general.

The ACC Guidelines and application are posted on the Village of PV and POA websites, and a hard copy of the application is located outside the Administration office. Once completed, deposit your information into the "drop box" or email the committee.

REMINDER

Property Owners are responsible for the aesthetics of their property. The Deed Restrictions do not allow for Owners to place items on their property that are in disrepair, disarray, or unsightly. You also cannot place your vessel, RV, trailer, or anything of the like on a vacant lot unless you own the adjacent lot (on the same street) <u>at any time.</u> If you do own the adjacent lot, you may only place items on the lot at a minimum 25' setback *after* the easement area. Therefore, if your easement is 5' from the street view, you will need to have your items 30' from the street.

Not everything is okay to put on your lot. Any personal property you place on your lot, must be in good, working condition, and, covered, if applicable, and you may never have any vehicle, vessel, etc. resting on blocks and/or jacks, or anything comparable.

GOLF NEWS...

I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for your support throughout 2022 and the beginning of 2023. The golf course and Caddie Shack have been extremely busy with revenues at an all-time high last year and we are well ahead of that pace already again this year.

Since it is so busy, I wanted to remind you of a few items on the golf side. Everyone must make a tee time and check into the golf shop to tee off on hole #1. Remember if you have filled out one of the Membership forms up here at the golf shop you are a Member of the golf course. For your convenience, all Members may make a profile on our website www.PointVentureGolf.com with the email address we have on file in our GolfNow system. You may then book a tee time through our website using your profile with no transaction fee. Once you have booked your tee time, please check into the golf shop. Just a reminder that you may use your private cart unlimited if you pay the \$110/ month trail fee. If you do not get to play enough to justify the \$110/month, we do offer a daily trail fee to use your own cart per round. The cost is \$15 per person for 9 holes or \$22 per person for 18 holes. If you do not have your own cart, you may rent one of ours for \$24 per person for 18 holes, or \$17 per person for 9 holes. Finally, please keep your carts on the cart path around the tees and greens and on all par 3's and no more than 4 players to a group.

Also, a reminder with our updated beer and wine license map, you may NO LONGER bring any Beer or Wine on to the golf course property. All beer and wine and mixers (anything under 14% alcohol) MUST be purchased at the Caddie Shack. Finally, all drinks must be in one of our cups, you may not bring any type of container such as a YETI on to the property. These rules are in place to protect our TABC license, not to be difficult. Additionally, there is no smoking (cigarettes or illegal drugs) or vaping in the Caddie Shack or on the outdoor deck. For your convenience we have created an area with tables, chairs, and ash trays outside the glass garage doors for smoking cigarettes and vaping. Please help us by abiding by all the rules that have been put in place – THANK YOU!

We had a tough winter with the overseed and the ice storm! Like most courses in Central Texas we had a lot of poa annua on the greens and thousands of limbs down all over the golf course. We sprayed the poa annua early so the greens were not so bumpy, but the Bermuda grass has not fully come out of dormancy yet. We need some warm nights to get the Bermuda growing! As far as the ice storm goes, we made the course playable within a couple days by getting all the limbs off the ground, but we will continue to cut down hanging limbs for the next month or so. We also completed a large irrigation system maintenance project this winter to help us get better coverage on the golf course this year and hopefully eliminate hot spots in the main playing areas this summer. Once we get some warmer weather and start getting this Bermuda growing, the golf course should be in awesome condition here in a couple months!

GOLF NEWS Continued...

We have our weekly golf leagues in the morning at 9am including Maddog Mondays, Women's Golf Association on Tuesday, Men's Golf Association Wednesdays, Thursday Mixed League, and the Friday Cash Game. We also have a 9-hole scramble on Saturdays at 3pm. We also have a major tournament every 3 weeks or so on the weekends and are adding a Men's League on Tuesday nights at 5pm, our Wednesday Night Scramble at 5pm, a Skins Game at 12:30pm on Thursdays, and a Women's League at 5pm on Thursday nights for those of you who work during the week. Make sure you get signed up on our Golf Genius Tournament Software, so you receive all the invitations for these great events.

We also have all of our nightly activities in the Caddie Shack and our rotating food trucks. The food trucks are going to start being there from 9am-9pm seven days a week! 


